Section 806.14, *Change in Title—Certification*. Wherever the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a case tried by a district court, the clerk of the district court is charged by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a case tried by a district court shall certify the same under the seal of said court to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
