Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by a judgment or decree of the district or real estate court, or by a judgment or decree of the district or real estate court, or by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify and file in the office of the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
