Section 636.14. Change of Title. — Whenever the title to any real estate is transferred to any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of a probate court, or by a decree of a court of record, or by a decree of a court of equity, or by a decree of a court of law, or by a decree of a court of chancery, or by a decree of a court of appeals, or by a decree of a court of last resort, or by a decree of a court of any other name, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the district court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
