Section 6814. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment of a court of appeals, or by a judgment of the supreme court, or by a judgment of the supreme court of the United States, or by a judgment of the supreme court of any other state, or by a judgment of the supreme court of any other country, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, and the same shall be recorded in the county auditor's office of the county in which said land is located.
