Section 206.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by a decision of the county auditor, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, or order of a court of record, the county auditor shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
