Section 635.14. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any real estate finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, where the title of the land is in dispute, comes up for review, recording or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
