Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any person, partnership, firm, or corporation is changed by judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by a court of law, the auditor of the county in which said real estate is situated shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
