Section 686.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, and it is thereafter determined by the court that a change of title is required, the court may, upon application of the party interested, order that the title be changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in the court having jurisdiction of the matter, and the court may, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
