Section 681.14. Change in Title. — Confirmation. Where the tax of several estates is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of the supreme court, and the same is not subject to a writ of error, the auditor of the district court shall, upon the filing of a petition for change of title, cause the same to be changed, and the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the court, to the auditor of the county in which said land is located.
