Section 605.14. Change in Title. - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by a judgment or decree of the district court and is changed by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify of the change and the date of the same to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
