Section 605.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or the county auditor, and the same is duly recorded, and the same is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify under seal of the court, and the county auditor shall certify under seal of the county in which said land is located.
