Section 606, 14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by a court of record or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment of a court of record, the county auditor shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
