Section 60614. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or corporation, and the same is thereafter changed by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court, or by any other legal proceeding, the auditor, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
