Section 6814. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by the sale or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by the order of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by the order of a probate court, the clerk of the court shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
