Section 606.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment, decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the court, or the auditor of the county in which said land is located, shall certify and cause to be recorded in the county in which said land is located.
