Section 606.14. Change in Title. — Confirmation. Where the title to any real estate is transferred in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title is so transferred by a private deed, and the person or persons to whom the same is transferred, or the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
