the title to any land is transferred to any person
or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by
a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate
is conveyed to a person or persons by a deed, mortgage or other
instrument, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same
under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the
county in which said land is located.
