Section 606.14. *Change in Title — Certification.* Whenever the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate in a decision by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
