Where the auditor of a county has received any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is in dispute, he shall, if the title is in dispute, certify to the clerk of the district court, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
