Section 6814. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of the supreme court, and such title is thereafter changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, and the same shall be filed in the county auditor's office of the county in which said land is located.
