Section 663.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court, and a copy of such judgment or decree is filed in the office of the auditor of the county, the auditor, on application of the person or persons claiming title to such real estate, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify, true or false, under the seal of the district court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
