Section 60614. *Change in Title — Certification.* Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding by a judgment or decree of the district court or by or persons for a judgment or decree of the district court, or a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is established by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a proceeding by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a proceeding, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
