Section 625.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, the title of the estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify, and submit to the county auditor, a copy of the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
