Section 668, 14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in court or by a judgment, decree, or order of a court of competent jurisdiction, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or in any other manner, the auditor of the county in which said real estate is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
