Section 6064. Change in Title. Confirmation. When the auditor of a county is duly qualified in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or when the auditor is removed from office by the district court, the auditor, or his successor, or under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
