Section 684. Change of Title.—Certification. Where the auditor has issued a certificate of title in favor of a person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, will, proceeding, or order in a cause, or a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in a probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same under the seal of said court to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
