Section 686, 14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the title to said estate or persons, and the same is duly recorded, the title to said estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
