Section 606.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, and the same is thereafter changed by any decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court, the county auditor shall certify to the county in which said land is located.
