

Section 606.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, or by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the county court, and the title is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, together with a copy of the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
