

Section 606.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding in any court of record, or in any court of record by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or contract, the auditor of the county in which said real estate is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
