Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to any real estate is transferred to any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a petition of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred to any person or persons by a deed, or by a probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
