Section 636. Change in Title. Confirmation. When the auditor of a county shall receive a duly certified copy of any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is being transferred by deed, mortgage, or other instrument, and the auditor is satisfied that the same are correct and conform to the records, he shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor or the county in which said land is located.
